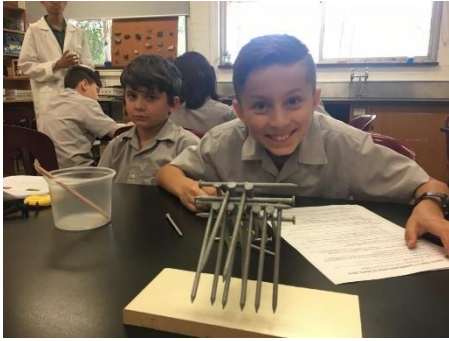
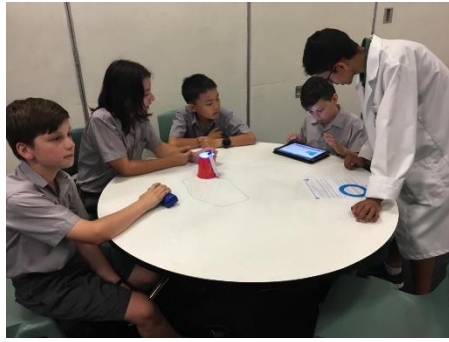
Year 6 Farewell Dinner - 6pm start and parents invited to join the students from 8.30pm, finish 9pm


